The Head Coach of the American Legion High School Baseball Team is responsible for overseeing the development, organization, and administration of the baseball program in accordance with American Legion Baseball rules, while fostering an environment of teamwork, sportsmanship, discipline, and respect. The coach will work with student-athletes (typically aged 13 –19) to improve their skills and prepare them for high-level competition.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Plan, organize, and conduct practices and games during the spring and summer season.
- Provide leadership and mentorship to student-athletes on and off the field.
- Teach fundamental baseball skills, strategies, and techniques.
- Oversee team selection, lineup decisions, and in-game strategies.
- Ensure compliance with American Legion Baseball rules and code of conduct.
- Maintain open communication with players, parents, assistant coaches, and Legion leadership.



- Coordinate transportation, scheduling, equipment, and uniforms with team and post officials.
- Foster academic accountability and positive community representation among players.
- Promote player safety through adherence to health and safety guidelines, including pitch counts and injury prevention.
- Represent the team and organization in a professional and positive manner.
